Slice off one end so you have a straight bottom edge.


For the top, slice your wrap into a point/triangle shape. Take these two pieces and put them below to make a tail for your rocket.

If you have longer pepper or carrot slices, they can be the fire coming from your rocket.


You can also use bread and cut it into a rocket/triangle shape. Enjoy!
