The **Senior Friend Program** promotes social engagement of older adults in Pierce County by pairing volunteers with older adults aged 60+ who are homebound and socially isolated. (*In partnership with Lutheran Community Services Northwest.*)

Participants may receive:

- Companionship, Transportation, Activities
 Volunteers Needed!
 - Must be 21+, have had a flu vaccine, and agree to weekly contact

The Care Pairs Program offers tools, guidance, and encouragement. Unpaid caregivers will receive weekly check-ins from staff and help with:

- Resources
- Safety tips
- A listening ear

It is free to participate in both programs.

To qualify for both programs you must be:

- 60 years+ for Senior Friends
- Care Pairs Caregiver needs to be 60+
- Lonely or Isolated
- Willing to participate in regular visits
