




























#### Recipes, Games, and Activities

Wear and eat!!


#### Count-Down Rhyme: Apple Roll


Five little apples in the bowl







Trace the lines to connect the apples to the trees.






### TRACE AND COLOR

Draw a curved and short line, start at the apple.


#### 2) Color the apples.
