# GETTING STARTED IN PIERCE COLLEGE ADULT DIPLOMA - PCAD

- Quarters typically start in January, April, July and September
- Morning or evening classes are Monday through Thursday
- Classes are offered in-person or online, schedule subject to change
- Cost is \$25 per quarter with a tuition waiver available
- Staff assist students with intake and class registration
- No cost for books, we use Open Education Resources online (OER)
- High school transcripts are accepted and evaluated for credit toward high school diploma

### ITRANS QUARTER – TRANSITION TO COLLEGE LEVEL

- Students complete last quarter of HS Diploma requirements and first quarter of college level classes during the ITRANS quarter
- ITRANS quarter college tuition is paid for by the college approximately \$1100.00
- Students are paired with a Navigator during their ITRANS quarter to assist with transition to college
- Official Washington State High School diploma is awarded by Pierce College upon completion of ITRANS quarter
