










#### **Books About Nocturnal Animals**




























#### Rhymes, Songs, and Activities

#### Nocturnal Animal Search and Find What you need:

A flashlight

Toys or stuffed animals (or pictures)

of animals that are nocturnal

Hide toy animals around your home or around one room in your home.

Once they are hidden, turn off most (or all!) of the lights.

Using your flashlight, search for these animals together until you find them all.



#### **Animals Sort: Daytime or Nighttime?**

Talk together about animals that are nocturnal (they are awake at night and sleep during the day) and animals that are diurnal (they are are awake during the day and sleep at night).

Can you name some of each type?

Can you draw a picture of a nocturnal and a diurnal animal? Together, you can also make a chart and write the names (or draw pictures) of animals that are nocturnal on one side and diurnal on the other.

Repeat with mouse, wolf, owl, fox, hedgehog, and any other animals you like!


If you have a picture or toy of any of these animals, bring them out when you say this guessing rhyme.

Draw a Sun in the daytime picture.




