Q&A and Updates to the RFP

Q: How many of the 88 license renewals are for indoor and how many are for outdoor? Or is it 88 of each?
A: The current number of license renewals is for 26 external wireless access points and 62 internal wireless access points, for a total of 88 licenses. As noted in the RFP:

“The Library seeks 88 annual licensing renewals in 2025 for both indoor and outdoor Xirrus WAPs equipment with the following licensing Product Number and description: XMSC-EDU-RNW-1-2R XMS-Cloud 1-year subscription renewal: for Education: 2 and 3-radio AP with all EasyPass modules and Cambium Care Advanced Support (or equivalent). The maximum number of licenses needed over the term of the contract could be up to 118.” and

“Proposals should include the unit price for every product (or equivalent) listed above, even if not projected to be purchased in 2025. The Library will work with the winning proposer to finalize the exact models and quantities that best meet the Library’s technical and financial needs for 2025 and future contract years.”
