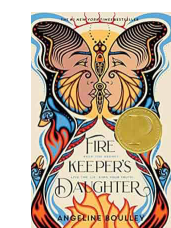

**Free Tax Prep**


The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program provides free tax preparation services to thousands of moderate and limited-income Pierce County residents each year during the tax season.
