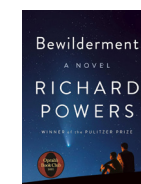

Virtual Author Talk with Amanda Peters*

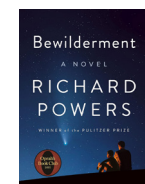
