Virtual Dungeons and Dragons: The Ongoing Campaign*

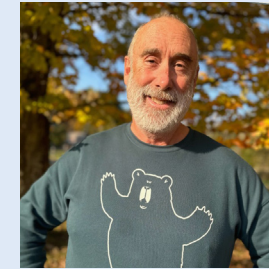
