Pierce County Library Board of Trustees to hold June 10 meeting

PIERCE COUNTY, Washington – The Pierce County Library System’s Board of Trustees will hold its regular meeting **Wednesday, June 10, at 3:30 p.m.**

The meeting agenda includes a Comprehensive Capital Plan report, including recommendations and detailed information about the Bonney Lake, Buckley and Sumner libraries.

Additional agenda items include:

- State Auditor’s Office 2025 Annual Report.
- Update on the 2024 financial and accountability audits.
- Timeline for development of the 2027 budget.
